Both hiking groups will start out together at 1:30 p.m. at Weis Ecology Center's outer parking lot (150 Snake Den Rd, Ringwood NJ 07456). Or if preferred, hikers can also meet Don at 1:10 p.m. at the Farmers Market and follow Don to Weis.

Anyone who buys a copy of the book (West Milford Baker's Dozen) hikes for free; otherwise, a \$5 donation to NJ Audubon's Weis Ecology Center is suggested.
